EMERGENCY ORDINANCE #2018-01

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE IN THE AFTERMATH OF HURRICANE MICHAEL ADDRESSING IMMEDIATE NEEDS DUE TO THE IMPACT AND DESTRUCTION FROM THIS NATURAL DISASTER.

This Ordinance imposes a temporary moratorium against burning inside the City limits in order to mitigate the risk of fire and other health hazards.

It further imposes a temporary moratorium on clearing of debris on City rights-of-ways by private individuals in order to prevent damage to city infrastructure.

It further authorizes City personnel to undertake any action necessary to restore or maintain services, including, but not limited to, going on to private property.


This, Emergency Ordinance will remain into effect until further notice.
