REGULAR MEETING

6:30 P.M.

Chairman Durwood Stewart called this meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. with Councilmembers Brigham Shuler, John Ritter, and Vice-chairman Tom Clemons present. Attorney D. Jackson Summers, Mayor Steven Cutshaw, and Assistant City Clerk Nicole DeVeaux were present. Councilwoman Ellen Lewis and City Clerk Robin Hatcher were not in attendance.

Councilman Ritter offered the Invocation. Councilman Shuler led the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Council moved to approve the Agenda with the addition of Item 5-2: Discuss Project Hero.

Councilman Shuler moved to approve the previous month's minutes, seconded by Vice-chairman Clemons, all voted in favor.

Vice-chairman Clemons moved to approve the bills for payment, seconded by Councilman Ritter, approved by all.

No action was taken regarding, Item 8, a request by Ms. Barbara Whitfield to separate the sewer connections at two of her rental properties so that each will have its own cut-off/back-flow valve where it connects to the City's sewer main.

Mr. Shuler moved to approve Grinder Pump Grant Application and Loan/Lien Agreement #13673 which consists of a grant for \$800.00 and a Loan/Lien Agreement in the amount of \$900.00 for the replacement of a Grinder Pump for applicant #13673. Vice-chairman Clemons seconded this motion. All voted in favor.

Chairman Stewart called a Workshop to be held on Monday, March 19, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. for the purpose of discussing Nuisance Abatement Ordinance #04-04.

Councilman Shuler moved to Table Item 13, seconded by Councilman Ritter, all voted in favor.

Vice-chairman Clemons moved to authorize Clerk Hatcher/Chairman Stewart to explore funding options for purchase of a new tractor with a street sweeper attachment, seconded by Councilman Shuler, carried by all.

There being no further business, Councilman Shuler moved to adjourn, seconded by Councilman Clemons, all voted in favor. Meeting adjourned at 7:50 p.m.
