CITY OF BRISTOL
REGULAR MEETING

6:30 P.M.

Chairman Woody Stewart called this meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. with Councilmembers Tom Clemons, Ellen Lewis, Brigham Shuler, and John Ritter present. Attorney D. Jackson Summers and City Clerk Robin Hatcher were also present. Mayor Steven Cutshaw was not in attendance.

Reverend Terry Blackburn offered the opening prayer. Councilman Shuler led the Pledge of Allegiance. Councilman Shuler moved to approve the Agenda after striking Item #13, seconded by Councilman Ritter, all voted in favor.

Councilman Ritter moved to approve the previous month's minutes, seconded by Vice-chairman Clemons, carried by all.

Councilman Shuler moved to approve the monthly bills for payment, seconded by Councilman Ritter, approved by all.

Reverend Terry Blackburn addressed the Council during the Public Comment segment of the meeting. He informed the Council that the Church and parsonage had both experienced multiple grinder pump issues since replacing their original grinder pumps with a different brand pump. He requested that the council assist in some way with the cost of those repairs. No action was taken, however, the City's engineer was asked to analyze the specs of the pump that the church purchased and installed at each location to ensure that the specs meet the standards recommended for pumping into the city's central sewer system.

Councilman Clemons moved to accept the Audit Report and Financial Statements as prepared for FY ending 09/30/2017, seconded by Councilman Shuler, unanimously approved.

Councilman Clemons moved to formally establish that in the event of a tie council vote the Mayor will cast the tie breaking vote, seconded by Councilman Ritter, carried by all.

The City of North Miami requested that the Council consider adoption of a resolution prohibiting gun shows on government property in Florida. No action was taken.

There being no further business, Councilman Shuler moved to adjourn, seconded by Councilman Ritter, all voted in favor. Meeting adjourned at 7:30 p.m.
